In this production, Lynette delves into her personal struggle, using jazz, Hebrew cantorials, folk and rock music to create the framework for this performance. TAPIT/new works associate director Donna Peckett adds rhythm dance to the musical mix of **soul JOURNEY**.

Lynette's story is told through monologues by TAPIT/new works associate director Danielle Dresden, who wrote the script. Dresden joins Peckett in humorous scenes looking at the lighter side of society's attitudes towards mental health, from a meeting of Over-Achievers Anonymous to a visit to the self-help grocery store.

soul JOURNEY taps into our common humanity, stressing humor even as it explores tough issues.
